

Privacy Policy

The Alberni District Fall Fair will follow the privacy disclaimer laid out on our website and attached to this document to ensure we have been prudent with any personal information we collect on our clients, customers and members and to make sure it is one of our highest priorities.

Rational:

The Alberni District Fall Fair recognizes the need for a personal protection privacy policy to comply with the private sector privacy legislation and the protection of personal information with respect to our clients, customers and members.

At the Alberni District Fall Fair (ADFF) we are committed to providing our clients, customers, and members with exceptional service by maintaining the accuracy, confidentiality and security of the personal information that is in the organization's custody or under the organizations control.

Protecting Your Privacy

ADFF recognizes your right to privacy and pledges to protect it.

While we have always respected our clients, customers, member's privacy and safeguarded

their personal information, we have strengthened our commitment to protecting personal information because of British Columbia's Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA). PIPA sets out the grounds rules for how BC businesses and not for profit organizations may collect, use and disclose personal information. We will inform our clients, customers and members of why and how we collect, use and disclose their personal information, obtain their consent where required, and only handle their personal information in a manner that a reasonable person would consider appropriate in the circumstances.

We may collect, use or disclose personal information in the following circumstances:

- When the collection use or disclosure of personal information is permitted, or required by law,
- in an emergency that threatens an individual's life, health, or personal security, when personal information is available from a public source (eg: a telephone directory)
- when we require legal advice from a lawyer
- for purposes of collecting a debt,
- to protect ourselves from fraud
- to investigate an anticipated breach of an agreement or contravention of the law
- exhibitor's entries,
- vendor information
- seasonal rentals
