## ALL ANIMALS MUST BE PROPERLY IDENTIFIED WITH CANADIAN IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM

- All animals entered for competition must be registered prior to show and entries are paid.
- Entry closing date is August 22, 2025.
- 4-H Members are welcome to show in all Open Livestock Classes.
- Both 4-H and Open Championship & Reserve Classes are Rosettes Only (no extra prize money)
- Stall space allotted as determined by the Barn Supervisor. (special requests may be considered if submitted with entries)
- The Alberni District Fall Fair reserves the right to refuse any animal that show evidence of contagious diseases or parasites. The Agriculture Director on advice of the Consultant Veterinarian is authorized to refuse animals that are not in apparent good health. Animals displaying unruly & unmanageable behavior will be asked to leave.
- All exhibits must be penned before 5pm on Thursday and may not be removed prior to 9pm Saturday without first applying to the Agriculture Director at time of entry. (Consideration will be given to exhibitors from the mainland). Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of prize money. Vehicles will be allowed on the grounds after the Fair closes at 11 pm. Animals must be removed from the barns by 9am Sunday.
- No overnight sleeping in the barns
- Exhibitors to display your Farm Name & Breed type at your pens. Exhibitors are to keep their stalls or pens neat and presentable.
